Kabhi Khushi Kabhie Gham is a story of members from a family who are having fun, loving and caring for each other. There are also clashes as the people learn to cope with their problems. The film starts with the birth of twins, who grow up to be Sanjay and Rahul - both loved by everyone in their family. After some time, they both fall in love with Nandini - which leads to a clash between them as one sister-in-law will never be enough. The eventual conclusion of the film is that it's important for families to be together despite individual troubles. They have memories together which no one can take away from them. Falling in love was never this complicated.

Aamir Khan spent four months shooting for the film Kabhie Khushi Kabhie Gham, getting into the skin of each character that he played. He had to wait for six months before he got the schedule to shoot. He regrets not having done this earlier in his career, though he did work out religiously for this one role, leaving no muscle untouched. Aamir said that it was very difficult to play three different characters in the film. According to him it is because of the age factor- one body at 25 years could be different from another at 35 years and so on. Aamir and director Zoya Akhtar had planned to shoot sequences in London, but Aamir got sick during the shoot and they had to stop. Shabana Azmi plays the role of Rahul's mother in Kabhi Khushi Kabhie Gham. She is also the only person from the original team of actors to be featured in this version of the film. She said that Aamir Khan makes people feel connected to him and that he will be an actor with lasting appeal. She further added that she would like to do more films in English and hopes that she will get a chance in this regard. Shahrukh Khan was the first to be cast. He plays the role of Rahul Mehra, a successful film producer. Aamir Khan plays three different roles - Rahul Mehra, his father Jugnu and DJ Stu- all of whom are very close to each other. He said that he decided to work with Zoya Akhtar because she is very good at what she does and that he has never seen anyone who is as committed as her. Aamir Khan along with his co actors shot for about 67 days in Film City, Goregaon for this film.

The soundtrack consists of seven songs composed by Jatin Lalit with lyrics provided by Mehboob. The song "Humko Aajkal Nahi Hai" was composed by Aamir himself, making this the first time he composed, wrote lyrics and sang a song for a film he appeared in.

Kabhi Khushi Kabhie Gham faced controversy over its similarities to the 1990 American film "Memories of Me" starring Bruce Willis. The original movie was similar to that of an Indian family and also featured identical characters. The film had been distributed by Ramesh Sippy's company and Khan claimed that Sippy had even complimented him on his role as Rahul Mehra.
